Spectators are strongly discouraged. The Regatta will limit the number of races on the day to enable us to have longer time gaps between races.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions race capacity will be greatly reduced and entries may be suspended sooner if capacity is reached early.

Notes:

- 1. Competitors and coxes may only enter once per division.
- 2. Doubling up of boats and blades in the same division is not permitted due to strict boating times. Failure to adhere to boating times could result in disqualification.
- 3. Division times are approximate and may be altered depending on entries.
- 4. Masters events will use the masters handicap system where appropriate. If entries permit masters entries may be banded prior to the application of the handicap system. Please enter the age category the crew is eligible to compete at.
- 5. The Regatta will make every effort to accommodate competitors racing in their chosen event. Where competition is limited an entry may be placed in the next most suitable event unless it is clearly indicated not to do so on the entry.
- 6. The Regatta invites entries from competent crews only as Covid restrictions will limit assistance on and off the water.
- 7. Substitution must be made on BROE before boating for the crew's first race. If your event is banded then the substitution must have similar or fewer ranking points. Any individual with a positive Covid-19 test or who is displaying symptoms or is required to self isolate in relation to coronavirus can be substituted as a medical substitution under rule 7-2-4 (e). In either case the individual should not attend the event.
- 8. Single scullers may be subject to minimum ranking points if the event is over-subscribed. Priority will be given to single scullers with higher Ranking Indexes.
- 9. Entries close on Friday 28th May 2021 at 18:00. All entry fees must be paid by closing date to be put forward into the draw. The draw will take place on Sunday 30th May 2021, published shortly thereafter and will appear online at http://www.hexhamrc.co.uk/hexham-regatta. No refunds will be given once the draw has been done.
- 10. The Regatta reserves the right to limit the number of entries in an event, cancel an event or shorten the regatta course for safety or practical reasons.
- 11. In the event of total cancellation of the Regatta, the organisers will endeavour to refund entry fees paid after unavoidable costs have been been covered. In the event of partial cancellation no refunds will be made.
- 12. Every competitor and supporter attending the Regatta must complete track and trace details which will be in accordance with British Rowing and Government guidelines for 21 days. Failure to provide details will result in the entry being withdrawn.
